



Code of Conduct

- Adhere to all laws and regulations issued by the HNEC, relevant Libyan laws, and international code of conduct.
- Respect the rights of voters and candidates to freely express their views and participate in the elections.
- Respect the laws and the powers of the officials in charge of the electoral process, maintain public order, including respecting the host state's culture and customs, and compliance with the highest levels of professionalism at all times, even at rest periods.
- Not to interfere with or obstruct the electoral process in any way.
- Maintain absolute neutrality at all times and do not influence voters, candidates or staff members, exercise accuracy in judgment and draw conclusions from factual, verifiable evidence.
- Not to conduct any kind of electoral campaigning.
- Not to place, carry or display any political symbols or colors of a partisan nature or belonging to the candidate.
- Refrain from attempting to provide guidance or information to those involved in the electoral process or to interpret any kind on the current law, and refrain from attempting to resolve disputes.
- Place the accreditation card at a visible place when observing the electoral process.
- Not to take photographs of any material without a prior permission, and not to take any photographs that might affect the confidentiality and integrity of the ballot.
- Report any violations or irregularities that may undermine the electoral process (for observers and agents only).
- Follow the health protocol (established by the HNEC) related to the Covid-19 pandemic.
- The accreditation card is valid until its expiry date.
